Midlife and Beyond: Jungian Touchstones, October 29, 2009

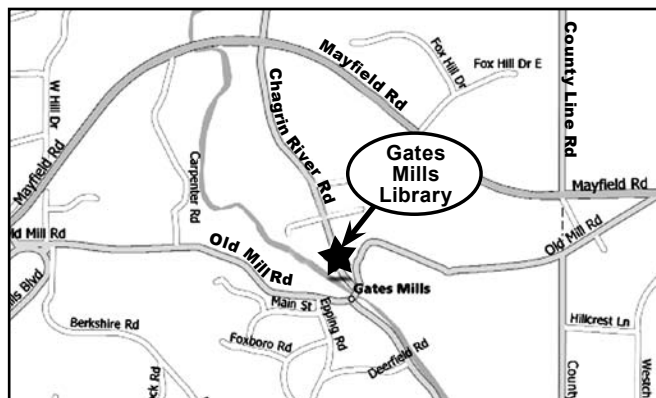
