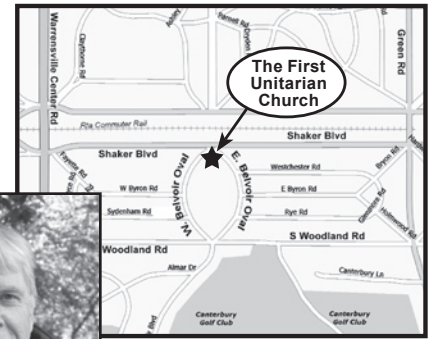

The Melting Polar Ice: An Archetypal Perspective on Climate Change

Today, we are witnessing the melting of the ice, a crisis of planetary dimensions. Dr. Romanyshyn will address this crisis from a Jungian-Archetypal point of view. He invites the audience to consider how the polar ice caps are not only geographical locations on the Earth, but also landscapes of the Soul. The ecological crisis is a psychological crisis—the melting polar ice is the expression of a planetary neurosis. Romanyshyn will end with the claim that this global climate crisis is not only a danger but also an opportunity for collective psychological transformation.

Research is a fundamental activity of the human psyche, which expresses the need to be creative. We will explore the ways in which one is drawn into his/her creative endeavors. The guiding analogy here is that research is re-search, a searching again for something that has already made its claim upon you.

Experiential work will be an essential part of the workshop. Participants will be invited to describe the creative work in which they are engaged, explore the complex roots of that work, and practice how to take hold of the work by letting go of it. Participants are asked to bring a description or example of their 'research.'
